Glossary of Terms

JCR/SJR impact factor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Journal Citation Reports (JCR), published by Thomson Reuters every year, provides quantitative tools for ranking, evaluating, categorizing, and comparing journals. • The impact factor is one of these; it is a measure of the frequency with which the average article in a journal has been cited in a particular year or period. • Unlike the JCR impact factor, the SJR impact factor in an open access journal metric that points to the frequency with which the average article in a journal has been cited in a particular year or period. • It is computed using the same formula as JCR impact factor is
Open-access charges	<p>For offering free online access, many publishers require the payment of an open access fee (also called an article processing charge).</p>
Hybrid open access	<p>This term is used to refer to a subscription-based journal where articles can be made open access after the payment of an article-processing charge.</p>
Automatic open-access after a period	<p>Also known as delayed open access, these are traditional subscription based journals that offer free online access upon the expiry of an embargo period following the initial publication date.</p>
